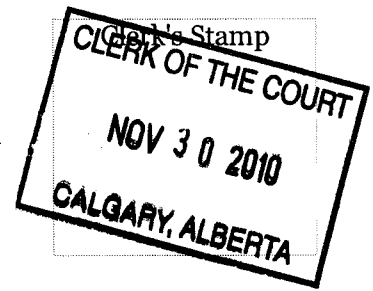

**RESTRICTED COURT ACCESS ORDER**

**UPON THE APPLICATION** of counsel for Alger & Associates Inc. in its capacity as receiver and manager (the "Receiver") of the assets, undertakings and property of Pro-Line Directional Services Partnership, Pro-Line Directional Services Inc. and 1260458 Alberta Ltd.; **AND UPON** having read the second report of the Receiver, filed November 24, 2010 (the "Second Report") and the confidential supplemental report of the Receiver, filed November 24, 2010 (the "Supplemental Report"); **AND UPON** hearing counsel for the Receiver, counsel for the Plaintiff HSBC Bank of Canada and from any other parties who may be present; **AND UPON** noting Part 6, Division 4, Rules 6.28 through 6.36 of the Alberta *Rules of Court*, Alta.

Reg. 124/2010; **AND UPON** it appearing that the relief proposed is just, fair and appropriate in all the circumstances and in the best interests of the receivership estate and the stakeholders affected thereby;

**THE COURT IS CONVINCED AND HEREBY ORDERS AND DECLARES THAT:**

1. The time for service of the application materials in support of the application for the restricted court access order in this matter (this "Order") is hereby dispensed with, and specifically, the service, notice and formal requirements of Rules 6.30, 6.31 and 6.32 are hereby dispensed with.
2. The Supplemental Report of the Receiver shall be treated as confidential, sealed and not form part of the public record, and shall be marked "Sealed Pursuant to Court Order", until the closing of the Transactions contemplated by the Contracts between the Receiver and the Purchasers (as those capitalized terms are defined in the Sale Approval and Vesting Order granted in this matter on November 29, 2010 by the Honourable Mr. Justice G.C. Hawco), at which time this Order will cease to have any effect and the sealing and confidentiality required by this Order will terminate.
3. The requirements of Rule 6.34 are hereby waived.
4. The Receiver is at liberty to reapply for further advice, assistance and direction as may be necessary to give full force and effect to the terms of this Order.
